

CONSENT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN:

Stacy Green, Registration No. LO 817; SCLP 2009
("the Member")

- and -

Saskatchewan College of Opticians Professional Conduct Committee
("the Committee")

WHEREAS the Saskatchewan College of Opticians received a written complaint dated February 25, 2022 from [REDACTED] a member of the public who is an [REDACTED] regarding the practice of the Member and identifying concerns about the manner in which the member dealt with him; and

WHEREAS the complaint was referred to the Committee for review and investigation in accordance with subsection 29(1) of *The Opticians Act* ("the Act"); and

WHEREAS, as a result of its investigation, the Committee has determined that the Member failed to provide adequate care, provided lens and frame details inappropriately, [REDACTED]; and

WHEREAS in the opinion of the Committee the Member would likely be found guilty by the Discipline Committee of professional misconduct, as that term is defined in section 27 of the Act, because the Member's conduct is either:

- (a) harmful to the best interests of the public or members; or
- (b) a breach of the regulatory bylaws which require members to comply with the Code of Conduct, and is therefore; and

WHEREAS the Committee is of the opinion that no further action with respect to the matter under investigation is warranted because the Member and the Complainant have consented to its resolution on the terms contained in this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Committee and the Member agree as follows:

Term of agreement

1. This Agreement applies to the period commencing on the date on which it is signed by the Member and ending on the date on which the Member has fully complied with all of the terms of this Agreement.

Essay required

2. The Member agrees to review the Code of Conduct contained in section 33 of the Regulatory Bylaws of the Saskatchewan College of Opticians and submit to the Chair of the Professional Conduct Committee, within six months after the date on which she signs this Agreement, an essay relating to the issues of professional responsibility and cultural sensitivity in providing services to patients that:
- (a) consists of at least 1,000 words;
 - (b) contains a minimum of three references and a bibliography; and
 - (c) summarizes how the Member would handle the situation that gave rise to the complaint differently if similar circumstances were to arise in the future.

Costs

3. The Member agrees to pay to the Saskatchewan College of Opticians the sum of \$300 in relation to the costs incurred by the College in the investigation of the complaint within six months after the date on which she signs this Agreement.

Breach of Agreement

4. The Member agrees that if she breaches any of the terms of this Agreement her licence will be suspended immediately, and the suspension shall continue until the circumstances are reviewed by the Committee.

Notice of change of contact information

5. The Member agrees to notify the Committee within seven days of any change in her contact information or employment.

Employers

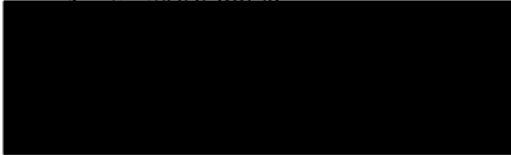
6. The Member agrees to provide her current employer, and any future employer by whom she is employed during the term of this Agreement, with a copy of this Agreement and the contact information for the ~~SECRET~~ Professional Conduct Committee, and shall provide the Committee with written confirmation from each such employer that she has done so.
7. The Member agrees to arrange for her current employer, and any future employer by whom she is employed during the term of this Agreement, to immediately report to the Committee any suspension or termination of her employment.

Report to Discipline Committee

8. As soon as this Agreement is signed, the Committee shall make a written report to the Discipline Committee recommending that no further action be taken with respect to the complaint because it has been resolved with the consent of the Complainant and the Member. In accordance with subsection 29(5) of the Act, the Committee shall provide copies of the report to the Council, the Complainant, and the Member
